not following instructions completely	Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Ephesians 6:1	loss of privilege
taking liberties that don't belong to you	He who ignores discipline comes to poverty and shame, but whoever heeds correction is honored. Proverbs 13:18	chastisement
doing regular chores or schoolwork poorly or with a bad attitude/whining	Diligent hands will rule, but laziness ends in slave labor. Proverbs 12:24	extra work
dawdling during regular chore time or school	The sluggard craves and gets nothing, but the desires of the diligent are fully satisfied. Proverbs 13:4	loss of free time

Unkind and Unloving Actions or Words:		
name calling, teasing, yelling at others, giving orders, picking fights, causing trouble	Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels. 2 Timothy 2:23	isolation
hitting, biting, kicking, throwing	Better a patient man than a warrior, a man who controls his temper than one who takes a city. Proverbs 16:32	chastisement
tattletale meddling, busybody	He who covers over an offense promotes love, but whoever repeats the matter separates close friends. Proverbs 17:9 Like one who seizes a dog by the ears is a passer-by who meddles in a quarrel not his own. Proverbs 26:17	isolation
abusing others' toys or belongings	If a man grazes his livestock in a field or vineyard and lets them stray and they graze in another man's field, he must make restitution from the best of his own field or vineyard. Exodus 22:5	fine or double restitution

Selfishness:		
refusing to play with others	Nobody should seek his own good but the good of others. 1 Corinthians 10:24	isolation
not giving others a turn, being greedy	Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you. Matthew 5:42	loss of possessions
coveting	Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have. Hebrews 13:5a	blessing journal
Character Traits:		
lying	The Lord detests lying lips, but he delights in men who are truthful. Proverbs 12:22	chastisement and 30 minutes early to bed
stealing	He who has been stealing must steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with his own hands, that he may have something to share with those in need. Ephesians 4:28	chastisement and double restitution
cheating	The Lord detests differing weights, and dishonest scales do not please him. Proverbs 20:23	chastisement and fine
proud attitude	The Lord detests all the proud of heart. Be sure of this: They will not go unpunished. Proverbs 16:5	chastisement and loss of privileges
Bad Habits:		
rude behavior, poor manners	Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves. Romans 12:10	loss of privileges
yelling and/or running in the house	Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. Philippians 2:4	isolation
wastefulness/carelessness	Not long after that, the younger son got together all he had, set off for a distant country and there squandered his wealth in wild living. After he had spent everything, there was a severe famine in that whole country, and he began to be in need. Luke 15:13-14	fine or loss of possessions

Penalties

- Isolation = 15-30 minutes bed arrest
- Loss of privileges = TV, playing with others, swimming, computer, any privilege related to the offense, etc.
- Loss of possessions = losing the toy that is being abused or causing a problem
- Blessing Journal = listing 10 things you have to be thankful for
